Update on Safety Plan

- No changes from San Joaquin County Office of Education.
- Additional updates may be shared.

Operations

- Three feet distance between students per updated CDPH guidance:
 - Furniture may need to be rearranged or removed/stored temporarily.
- More use of outdoor areas.
 - New outdoor tables at school sites.
- Each school will implement the site-specific plan.
 - Entrance/exit, recess/passing times, meal service
- Afterschool programs will resume and will follow safety measures.
- It is important to note that operations and classroom activities will not be as they were pre-pandemic.
- Adjustments may be needed as we progress through the year.

COVID-19 Testing

- Currently in place:
 - Opportunity for staff to be tested once every other month.
 - Opportunity to be tested when there is an outbreak.
- Considering options to offer weekly tests for students and staff:
 - Self-testing at school
 - Students would go to a designated area by class on a regular schedule.
 - Anonymous samples
 - \$18/test plus coordination (about \$500,000 per week).
 - Tests collected in groups of 8
 - If there is a positive reading in a group, all 8 individuals are tested
 - Pilot suggestion: Washington, Millswood, McNair

Timeframe

- The April 6, 2021, Board of Education Meeting includes an Action Item regarding the start date for full in-person instruction for all grade levels.
- A Distance Learning option will continue to be offered for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year.
