NEW Bylaws of the Board

Organization

Each year, the Board of Education shall hold an annual organizational meeting. In any year in which a regular election of district Board members is conducted, the organizational meeting shall be held within 15 days following the second Friday in December after the regular election. During all other years, the meeting may be held on any date in December, but no later than December 20th.

During any year in which a regular election is conducted, the Board, at the regular meeting held immediately prior to the second Friday in December, shall select the day and time of the organizational meeting. For any other year, the day and time of the organizational meeting shall be selected at the last regular meeting held immediately before the annual meeting. On behalf of the Board, the Superintendent shall notify the County Superintendent of Schools of the day and time selected. Within 15 days prior to the date of the annual meeting, the Superintendent shall notify in writing all Board members and members-elect of the date and time selected for the meeting.

At this meeting the Board shall:

- 1. Elect a president, vice president, and a clerk from its members
- 2. Authorize signatures, as needed
- Approve a schedule of regular meetings for the year
- 4. Designate Board representatives to serve on committees or commissions of the district, other public agencies, or organizations with which the district partners or collaborates

To be eligible for the presidency of the governing board, a member shall have served on the Board for a period of at least one year unless no such member is available.

The secretary of the Board shall be the Superintendent of Lodi Unified School District.
