Plans for Spending

What are the proposed expenditures for materials and supplies?

Expenditures to include a week long drama camp utilizing Missoula Children's Theater (MCT). MCT will send 2 directors as well as all of the props and costumes needed to put on a production for our families. The week long drama camp will include rehearsals after school as well as workshops for each classroom during the school day. Additional materials will not be needed.

The cost for this endeavor will be \$7829.80

Expenditures to include additional equipment for after-school clubs that will operate out of campus classrooms. Targeted activities and clubs include after-school performing arts clubs/groups, photography/video clubs, computer

coding clubs, music performance and composition clubs, as well as "maker" clubs (utilizing art materials and STEAM supplies).

What are the proposed expenditures for staffing and what are the focus areas (e.g. art, music, theater, STEAM, etc...)? Expenditures to include time cards for certificated and classified staff members to support clubs and activities. These expenditures are also inclusive of funds needed for hiring educational partnership programs and organizations to support STEAM clubs and activities.

Teacher Timecards: \$22,650.00

Classified Timecards: \$10,000.00

Benefits: \$5,657(certificated) + \$3,988.00(classified) = \$9645.00(total benefits)
