BEFORE THE BOARD OF EDUCATION of the LODI UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Concerning an Exemption to the CalSTRS Separation from Service Requirement

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code, Lodi Unified School District may seek an exemption to the CalSTRS separation from Service requirement for a CalSTRS retiree who is at or above normal retirement age at the time the compensation is earned, and the employer must appoint the retired CalSTRS member to a critically needed position that has been approved by the governing body of the employer at a public meeting as reflected in a resolution;

WHEREAS, Corinne Howe is a retired CalSTRS member who is at or above normal retirement age;

WHEREAS, the position of <u>Substitute Teacher</u> is a critically needed position and there is an extreme shortage of Substitute Teachers in the state of California which hold the required credential to perform these services;

WHEREAS, this action is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the 180-calendar day separation from service requirement is fulfilled;

WHEREAS, Corinne Howe did not receive a retirement incentive or any financial inducement to retire from any public employer;

WHEREAS, the retirement of Corinne Howe did not create the vacancy for which she will now be filling because there have been multiple vacancies in this position for several years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Lodi Unified School District that the District shall hire Corinne Howe as a Substitute Teacher for a period not to exceed the CalSTRS annual postretirement earnings limit for CalSTRS members
