EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Learning Communities for School Success Program (LCSSP) Grant

- In the 2016–17 school year, the District received the LCSSP grant award in the amount of \$1,701,032.00 for a three year period.
- The grant provided funding for the community liaison supervisor, 13 FTE community liaisons (2.5 liaisons were funded by the District), training, support of positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS) activities, and mentoring services provided by an outside consultant.
- Community liaisons work with students and parents/guardians on issues related to behavior, attendance, academics, and connection to resources.
- When the grant award sunsetted last school year, the District reapplied but did not receive funding.
- This year, the District will reapply again to the LCSSP grant to fund the community liaison supervisor, 13 community liaisons, training, PBIS activities, and mentoring services.
- If the application is funded, the District will enter into an agreement with the California Department of Education and will need to provide at least a 20 percent match in each year of the grant award period.
- The application is due on March 26, 2021.
