
# Lodi Unified School District Panorama SEL Survey Cycle 1

## **Executive Summary**

- Survey window May 3<sup>rd</sup> 21<sup>st</sup>
- All 3<sup>rd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students were given the opportunity to take the SEL survey
  - 13,656 students in grades 3-12 completed the survey
  - 64% Districtwide Response Rate
- SURVEY TOPICS: positive feelings, social awareness, self-efficacy, emotional regulation, sense of belonging, challenging feelings, and free response
  - Topics aligned to CASEL Competencies
  - National Benchmarks present for all topics
- Survey data provided insight on how sites can support students social-emotional well-being at the tier 1, tier 2, and tier 3 level
- Survey cycles for 2021-2022 school year:
  - Fall SEL survey window: August 30<sup>th</sup>- September 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Winter SEL survey window: January 17th- January 28th
  - Spring SEL survey window: May 2<sup>nd</sup>- May 13<sup>th</sup>

## **Bright Spot!**

Sense of Belonging had the most favorable response for grades 3-5.

\*Especially challenging for Panorama district partners given the pandemic and remote environment


> Overall, how much do you feel like you belong at your school?


75% responded favorably

At first glance, students in grades 6-12 responded 50% favorable to the questions on Positive Feelings



When we disaggregate the data in subgroups, SPED students and Foster/ Homeless students are experiencing positive emotions more frequently.





#### Grade 6-12




