**Seven Period Day at Comprehensive High Schools**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the Lodi Unified School District (Board of Education) has a responsibility to provide high quality education to all students; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has set a goal for the Superintendent to increase college and career readiness by providing opportunities in Career Technical Education pathways and A-G completion, the district will develop an alternative to the 6-period day; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has determined that implementation of a seven (7) period day at all comprehensive high schools not currently on a block schedule would provide a substantial educational benefit to students; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Education of the Lodi Unified School District authorizes the Superintendent to implement a seven (7) period day at all comprehensive high schools not currently on a block schedule in a manner which is compliant with law and in the best educational interest of the students.
