Elementary Summer School 2021

- Potential school sites: Borchardt, Clairmont, Lawrence, Reese, Silva, Wagner Holt
 - Number of sites depends on staffing
- 36 Teachers at this point
- With this staffing
 - Program offered at 3 of the above school sites
 - About 720 students
- June 14 - July 2
- 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- Transportation at designated hubs

Elevate Math

- Grades 3 - 9, 4 classes each
- Grade 10, 2 classes
- 30 teachers
- 515 students (as of April 29)
- Distance Learning Model

Middle School Summer Camps

Planning stages for potential summer programs:

- STEM Camp at the Maker Space Lab, SJCOE
- Durham Ferry Outdoor Education Center
- Coding Camp
- GATE program focused on STEM

High School Summer School 2021

- June 14 - July 16
- 46 teachers at this point
- 4 teaching positions left to be filled
- Semester 1: 1,461 students
- Semester 2: 1,226 students
- APEX: 103 students
- Total course requests: 3,696
- At time of position posting, District was in the purple tier and all DL, posting indicated the model may change to in-person.
- Initial planning was for DL.

Rationale for Distance Learning Model for High School Summer School 2021

- Allows more students to participate
 - 3 feet spacing will limit # of students in a classroom
- Keeps teachers who wish to teach DL
- Eliminates absences due to exposures/positive cases and allows students to complete the courses
- Eliminates concerns associated with students on campus during construction
- Allows for 1:1 tutoring
- Provides access and flexibility for students with summer conflicts
