III. Goal Changes

- Focused Equity Multiplier school goals (3-5 new goals)
 - In the 2023-24 LCAP, eligible LEAs were required to include one or more specific goal(s) to address one or more consistently low performing student groups or low performing schools.
 - The LCFF Equity Multiplier (Equity Multiplier) is a new funding program commencing with the 2023-24 school year.
 - Equity Multiplier funds must be used to implement evidence-based services and supports.
 - Equity Multiplier funds must be used to supplement, not supplant, other funding and/or services provided to Equity Multiplier schoolsites.
 - Each eligible school site will receive a minimum of \$50,000 in Equity Multiplier funds

IV. Actions Changes

- LEAs must include one or more specific actions within the LCAP if the LEA has Red indicators on the 2023 Dashboard for:
 - 1.a school within the LEA,
 - 2.a student group within the LEA, and/or
 - 3. a student group within any school within the LEA
- An action for LTELs must be added if you have more than 15 LTELs
- Beginning in the 2024-2025 LCAP, LEAs must change actions not proven effective over a three-year period
- All actions will be grouped with a metric

V. Required Metrics - New

- A. For LEA-wide actions contributing to increasing or improving services: For each action identified as 1) contributing towards the requirement to increase or improve services for foster youth, English learners, including long-term English learners, and low-income students and 2) being provided on an LEA-wide basis, the LEA must identify one or more metrics to monitor the effectiveness of the action and its budgeted expenditures.
- **B.** For each Equity Multiplier goal, the LEA must identify:
 - The specific metrics for each identified student group at each specific school site, as applicable, to measure the progress toward the goal, and/or
 - The specific metrics used to measure progress in meeting the goal related to credentialing, subject matter preparation, or educator retention at each specific school site.
