# Survey Methodology

#### RANDOM SURVEY OF LIKELY VOTERS CONDUCTED IN JANUARY 2024

- ► Surveys were conducted between 1/24/24 and 1/28/24 in English and Spanish
- ► 406 completed surveys
  - ▶ 46% text-to-web
  - ▶ 39% cell phones
  - ▶ 8% land lines
  - ▶ 7% email-to-web
- ► The average length of the survey was 11.75 minutes
- ► Margin of error for the survey is 4.864%










#### PERCEPTION OF EDUCATION QUALITY






#### PERCEPTION OF DISTRICT'S FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

How would you rate the quality of the fiscal responsibility of the Lodi Unified School District?





## Community's Most Important Asset






#### SCHOOLS IMPACT ON PROPERTY VALUES

# **Quality Schools Increase Property Values**






"With funds that cannot be taken by the State and spent elsewhere, shall Lodi Unified School District's measure to replace deteriorating portable classrooms; infrastructure including roofs, repair electrical wiring and plumbing; and construct new classrooms be adopted, authorizing \$212 million of bonds with legal rates, estimated levies below \$43 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation (raising \$12,800,000 annually), independent citizen oversight, annual audits, eligibility for state matching funds, full disclosure of spending and no increase in current tax rates?"


















