9-12 Textbook Selection Process

- 1. Textbook Selection Recommendation:
 - A. District Textbook Selection Committee Review
 - Committee Review
 - Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction Review
 - Assistant Superintendent of Secondary Review
 - **B. Site Textbook Committee Review**
 - a. All 9-12 Department Chairs reviews and sign
 - b. All 9-12 Principals reviews and sign
- 2. Technology reviews/sign **prior to submission** required for all textbooks. Submit a Web Help Ticket for review-allow sufficient time for this (2 weeks).
- 3. Curriculum Council Review

- Textbooks will be available at least one week prior to the Curriculum Council meeting for council members to review
- Curriculum Council will hear a report and a recommending vote will be taken.
- 4. Instructional materials will be publicly displayed for two weeks prior to the Board of Education meeting at which the materials will be presented. Each school board member will be provided an opportunity to preview the materials.
- 6. Board of Education Approval Action Item.

Curriculum Council 9-12 Textbook Review Process

- 1. Schedule a date for presenting a textbook to Curriculum Council with the Curriculum and Instruction office.
- 2. The following items must be submitted to the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction at least two weeks prior to the Curriculum Council Meeting:
 - Completed & signed 9-12 Textbook Selection Forms, including Instructional Materials Review Form.
 - Copy of the grade-level textbook.
 - Curriculum Council will hear a report and vote to do one of the following:
 - Recommend approval of the textbook/materials, or
 - Refer back for additional information.
 - The requested information will be presented for a vote at the next Curriculum Council meeting.

9-12 Textbook Report Format

Presentations to Curriculum Council should be limited to 10 minutes and include:

- 1. An overview of the textbook
- 2. Identification of special features
- 3. A recap of Textbook Selection Committee process
- 4. Evidence of how the textbook reflects the current framework, Common Core Standards and or Content Standards

- 8. Strength of textbook:
 - Textbook is very user friendly, chapters are broken down into smaller, more accessible modules.
 - Closest alignment to the AP Unit guides and pacing.
 - Annotated teacher's edition is a great resource for unit planning and new teacher support.
 - Math sections within the modules called "Do the Math" showing kids examples of problems and calculations.
 - In-chapter AP Exam tips, multiple choice review questions and glossary support student usability.
 - Study modules are available for student support.
 - ExamView question bank in addition to and independent of online summative and formative assessment questions and diagrams.
 - Multiple practice AP exams and math review section in back of the text.
 - Digital adaptive learning tool (Learning Curve)
 - Has a full practice exam along with supplements for AP preparation (Strive for a 5 Workbook)
- 9. Weakness of textbook:
 - Online resources are adequate, but not very interactive. Weak in data analysis tools.
 - Smaller AP question review per module with No practice FRQ per module, but ample at chapter level.
