















Lodi Unified Chronic Absenteeism Rate By Ethnicity

Considerations When Analyzing These Data

- Data reporting is not consistent and may be invalid when attempting to analyze trends that incorporate 2019-20
- CAASPP was suspended in 2019-20
- CAASPP test blueprints were significantly reduced (fewer questions) in 2020-21
- CAASPP 95% participation requirements for 2020-21 were waived
- Remote testing was problematic
- Districts were allowed to administer local assessments in place of SBAC
- Chronic Absenteeism was not reported for 2019-20
- Suspension rates in 2020-21 may not be comparable due to school closures

Moving Forward

- CAASPP 95% participation requirements have been reinstated
- Due to the high number of parent requests to opt children out of testing there
 may be challenges in meeting the 95% participation rate for 2021-22
- The 2020-21 CAASPP blueprints will continue to be used for 2021-22
- Remote testing remains available for 2021-22
- The 2020-21 California Dashboard has been suspended
