Health/Safety Requirements and Guidance

Executive Summary

AB 104

- Parents of last year's K-11 students who received deficient grades 2020-2021 may request a meeting to discuss retention. District has final decision.
- High school students may apply to change letter grade to Pass/No Pass (specified timeline).
- Last year's Juniors and Seniors not on track to graduate in 4 years are exempt from requirements beyond state graduation requirements.

Budget Trailer Bill Highlights (not all inclusive):

- District must offer Independent Study option, notify parents, and update Board Policies to address criteria.
- Phase in expansion of Transitional Kindergarten: programs for all children 4 years old in 2025-26 school year.
- Funds to help students who failed A-G courses retake them, includes tutoring, and PD for staff.
- Funds to develop/expand Ethnic Studies course offerings.
- Grants to create Community Schools to offer health and social services to students and families

Health/Safety Requirements and Guidance

- CDC update on masks: mask use indoors at school for all individuals who are not fully vaccinated.
- CDPH School Industry Guidance continues to require all individuals at schools to wear masks indoors. Schools follow this guidance.

Student Retention

- Effects students who received deficient grades for at least one-half of the coursework in 2020-2021.
- Within 30 days of receiving a written request from a parent to retain their child for the 2021-2022 school year, the district will offer the parent a meeting to include the parent, student, an administrator, and a teacher.
 - Discussion of learning recovery options
 - Consideration of the student's academic data
 - Discussion about research on the effects of retention and types of intervention/support that is beneficial
- District makes final decision within 10 days of meeting.

Pass/No Pass Grades

- Last year's high school students may apply to have a letter grade replaced with Pass/No Pass.
- CDE is to provide the application template within 15 days.
- Within 15 days of above, District will post information on website and provide written notice to students/families.
- Students have 15 days from district posting to apply.
- Change will occur within 15 days of student application.
- CSU must accept P/NP grades for students through 2023-24.

Local Graduation Requirements Exemption

 Applies to last year's Juniors and Seniors not on track to graduate in four years.

• District must provide students the opportunity to complete state graduation requirements.

• Students are exempt from local requirements beyond state requirements.

 Opportunity may include, but is not limited to, a fifth year of instruction or credit recovery.

Notice of Option to Parents/Guardians

- Lodi USD Options K-12
 - Independence School
 - Valley Robotics Academy
 - Digital Academy

- Parent has the right to request a meeting before enrollment, which includes discussions on:
 - Procedures for enrolling, disenrolling, re-enrolling.
 - Synchronous and asynchronous instruction time.

Board PolicieS to include:

- Criteria for student achievement, engagement, and progress.
- Content aligned to standards and access to courses for graduation and college entrance.
- Procedures for tiered re-engagement strategies for non-attendance or not meeting agreement.
- A plan to transition students to in-person instruction upon request.
- Daily live and synchronous instruction requirements.

Daily Live and Synchronous Instruction

- K-3
 - Daily synchronous instruction.
- Grades 4-8
 - Both daily live interaction and at least weekly synchronous instruction.
- Grades 9-12
 - At least weekly synchronous instruction .

Written Learning Agreement for each student to include: Access to needed devices and connectivity.

Identification of academic and other supports.

- Processes for:
 - Submission of student work
 - Reporting student progress
 - Communicating with parents regarding student progress.

Universal Transitional Kindergarten

Expansion of program starting 2022-23 school year.

• Services for all children who are four years old: 2025-26 school year.

• Adult: Student ratio of 1:10 by 2023-24 contingent on budget.

A-G Completion Improvement Grant Program

- Professional Development for teachers, administrators, and counselors
- Tutoring
- Advising
- Expanding access to coursework
- Fees for Advanced Placement tests
- Opportunities for students with D or F in A-G courses last spring and/or 2020-2021 school year to retake courses

Ethnic Studies

Community Schools

One-time grants for the Community Schools
Partnership program to establish new and expand existing community schools.

 Schools work with community agencies and providers to coordinate and offer health, mental health, and student support services to students and families.

 A funding match is required equal to one-third of the grant amount.

Application and selection process not yet available.

Health/Safety Requirements and Guidance

• CDC July 9, 2021, update included the use of masks indoors at schools for individuals not fully vaccinated.

However

- California Schools follow CDPH School Guidance.
 - July 9, 2021: California will continue to require that masks be worn indoors in school settings, which also will ensure that all kids are treated the same.
