Role of the .5 STEAM/VAPA Teacher

Development of Social-Emotional and Interpersonal Skills:

Social-Emotional Learning (SEL): The .5 STEAM/VAPA teacher will implement activities that foster emotional intelligence, self-awareness, self-regulation, empathy, and effective communication. This can include arts-based SEL programs where students express themselves through various art forms, facilitating emotional growth and social skills.

Interpersonal Skills: Collaborative projects in STEAM and VAPA encourage teamwork, communication, and conflict resolution. Students learn to work together towards common goals, enhancing their ability to interact positively with peers and adults.

Enhancement of Integrated Learning:

STEAM Education: The teacher will design and lead interdisciplinary projects that combine science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics. For example, students might create artistic representations of scientific concepts or use technology to produce and analyze art.

Guiding Inquiry and Problem-Solving: Through hands-on projects and inquiry-based learning, students are encouraged to ask questions, conduct experiments, and solve real-world problems. The integration of arts into these projects helps in visualizing and conceptualizing complex ideas.

Funding Breakdown and Utilization

62% (of the .5 Salary and Benefits) Prop 28 Funds:

Allocation: The majority of the funding will come from Prop 28, dedicated specifically to enhancing arts and music education. This covers the primary salary and benefits for the .5 STEAM/VAPA teacher.

38% (of the .5 Salary and Benefits) Supplemental Assistance to Schools:

Allocation: Due to the budget exceeding the amount provided by Prop 28, supplemental funds will cover the remaining expenses.
