NEW Bylaws of the Board

Oath or Affirmation

Prior to entering upon the duties of their office, all Governing Board members shall take the oath or affirmation required by law.

The oath may be administered and certified by a judicial officer, Board member, secretary or assistant secretary to the Board, Superintendent, deputy or assistant superintendent, principal, or County Superintendent of Schools or any other person authorized in Education Code 60, Government Code 1225, and 1360.

The executed oath shall be filed with the County Clerk.
