# Executive Summary

The key highlights include:

- Professional development and support by SCOE for ELSB
- CORE training
- Support from district coaches
- Senior teacher mentor for new teachers
- After-school paraprofessional support for early reading intervention and tutoring
- SIPPS peer walkthroughs and feedback
- Regular student progress report meetings and data discussions
- After-school program providing academic support aligned with the regular school program
- Strong teacher support
- 90-minute English Language Arts block for grades K-6
- Availability of mental health and counseling services for at-risk students
- Regular parent-teacher conferences and consistent communication with parents

# Kindergarten 2023-24 Results

## Kindergarten DIBELS results:

- 36% performing at or above the benchmark at the beginning of the year
- 60 % performing at or above benchmark at the end of the year
- This percentage is slightly higher than the school district average of 57% for all kindergarten students performing at or above the benchmark at the end of the year

# First Grade 2023-24 Results

## First Grade DIBELS results:

- 83% performing at or above the benchmark at the beginning of the year
- 45 % performing at or above benchmark at the end of the year
- This percentage is lower than the school district average of 63% for all first grade students performing at or above benchmark the end of the year

# Second Grade 2023-24 Results

## Second Grade DIBELS results:

- 50 % performing at or above the benchmark at the beginning of the year
- 74 % performing at or above benchmark at the end of the year
- This percentage is higher than the school district average of 58% for all second grade students performing at or above the benchmark at the end of the year

# Third Grade 2023-24 Results

## Third Grade iReady Reading results:

- 27% performing at or above benchmark the beginning of the year
- 53 % performing at or above benchmark end of the year
- This percentage is higher than the school district average of 46% for all third grade students performing at or above benchmark the end of the year
- CAASPP test results not available as of May 23,2024
