 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the CITY OF MANTECA (hereinafter "CITY") requests bids for Gasoline and Diesel Fuel Supplier Fiscal Years 2021/22 – 2025/26 (hereinafter "Project"), and will receive bids in the office of the Public Works Department, City Clerks Office, 1001 W. Center Street, Manteca, California, 95337 up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., on the 17th day of June, 2021.

2. Each bid must conform to the requirements of the Request for Bid, General Contract Conditions, Technical Specifications and General Service Agreement comprising the Agreement Documents. Bid are to be submitted using the Bid Form attached herewith.

Bids are to be submitted in the form of cents-per-gallon (rounded to the nearest thousandths of a cent) markup over/under the **OPIS Stockton Daily Rack Average.** The markup bid shall remain firm for the length of Agreement. Contractor shall deliver the lowest available priced product (use lowest priced supplier of fuel). To assist the City in evaluating bids, each Bidder must supply sample price for unleaded gasoline and diesel for May 27, 2021, and June 2, 2021 (see Page 2 of the Bid Form). PLEASE NOTE: These sample prices do not necessarily determine the lowest bid for award of Agreement. The City uses these same prices as estimates for total annual fuel costs. The City's primary factor for determining the award of Agreement is the cents per gallon markup/down.

3. The services to be performed by the successful Bidder are described in the Bid. Copies of the Bid are available at the City Clerks office and online at City of Manteca Webpage: <u>https://www.ci.manteca.ca.us/Engineering/Pages/Projects-Out-To-Bid.aspx</u>. The City shall not be responsible for any explanation or interpretation of the bid other than by a written addendum posted to the City's website no later than 5:00 p.m. Thursday, June 10, 2021. No oral interpretations of any provision in the bid will be given.

4. Bids must be delivered to the Public Works Department, in care of the City Clerk located at 1001 W. Center Street, Manteca, California, 95337 no later than 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 17, 2021, in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside with a return address and the statement below:

"SEALED BID FOR GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL SUPPLIER FY 2021/22 - 2025/26 DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL"

5. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities. The City will award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder. The City may award a contract to the next lowest responsible bidder if the successful bidder refuses or fails to execute the contract. The City also reserves the right to reduce/increase the scope of work for fuel delivery should the City's fuel needs change.

Authorize a call for Bid for the City of Manteca Fuel Contract. Establish authorizations for City Manager to sign all contract and amendments pertaining to the Fuel Contract.

Background:

The City of Manteca's fuel contract expired June 30, 2019. This contract was maintained by the prior Finance Department, Public Works will be now be maintaining it.

Staff is recommending moving forward to solicit bids to purchase gasoline and diesel fuel in bulk quantity for the City's vehicles and equipment. By purchasing in bulk, the per-gallon cost is lower resulting in a savings for the City. The fuel will be delivered to the City as needed. Staff is recommending for expediency that the City Manager receive authorization to review bid tabulations and sign any contract documents and/or amendments that will expedite the fuel contract process. Attached is the documentation that will be used to solicit said bids.

Recommended Action:

- A. Authorize Director of Legislative Services/City Clerk sign to Notice to Contractors;
- B. Authorize the Department of Public Works to advertise for competitive bids;
- C. Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder; provided the contract amount does not exceed available funds or to reject all bids; and
- D. Authorize the City Manager to approve all change orders, amendments, provided the contract amount does not exceed available funds for the project.

Fiscal Impact:

Gasoline and diesel fuel is funded through various City departments/division accounts, including the General Fund. Sufficient funds will be requested in the Fiscal Year 2021/22 Preliminary Budget to address projected costs associated with a new contract.
