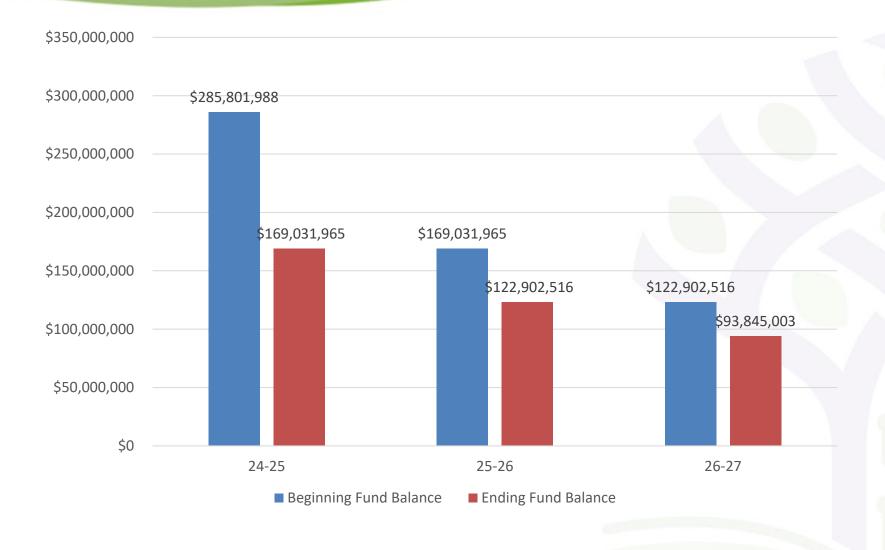

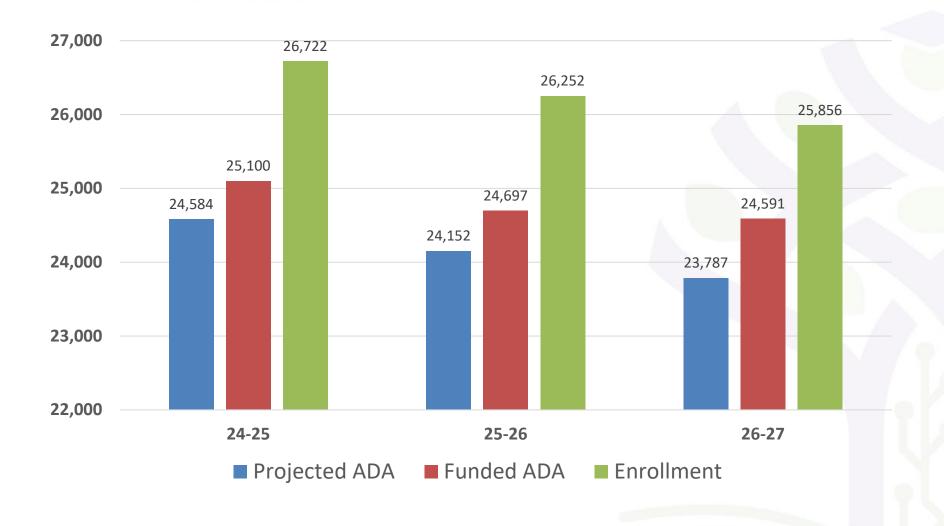


Ending Fund Balance Projections
