Board to Determine Process to Fill Board Vacancy Area 6: Provisional Appointment or Special Election

Neil Young, Associate Superintendent, stated that due to the resignation of Board Member, Ron Freitas, a process to fill the vacancy in Area 6 by election or provisional appointment is needed.

Board Members commented they would be in favor of the provisional appointment process, as they agreed that the estimated expenditures to conduct a special election would be better utilized for other District expenses.

Should the Board approve the Provisional Appointment process, the Board will approve a timeline such as described in the attachment

As the Board approved to proceed with a provisional appointment, Associate Superintendent Young reviewed the steps and proposed timeline necessary to begin the process:

Advertisements will be placed in The Record and Lodi News-Sentinel as soon as possible
and posted to the District website and social media platforms. The display ads in the

newspapers will run every weekend leading up to the deadline for candidate submissions.

- The deadline is February 8, 2023 at Noon to submit a letter of interest and resume.
- A Board-appointed ad hoc committee would review submissions to determine that candidates have met qualifications and make an appointment at a Special Board Meeting on February 23.
- As per California Ed. Code and Board Bylaw, the public would be noticed of the
 appointee via newspapers, social media platforms, and posted in at least three public
 places within the District. The public would have 30 days to present a petition to the
 San Joaquin County Superintendent of Schools calling for a special election.
- If no successful petition is submitted, the appointee would take the oath of office and begin service at the Regular Board Meeting of March 28.
